What good is a Camp without a cook? And (as you all KNOW), we've got the BEST!

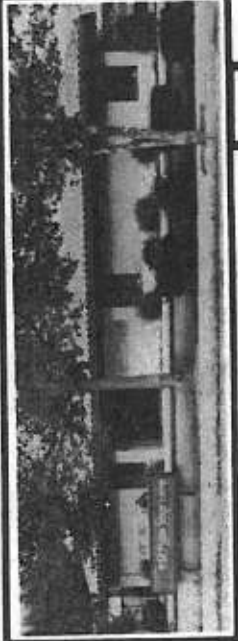
NANA has been associated with the Camp since 1958, and has cooked thousands of fantastic meals in that time. Not

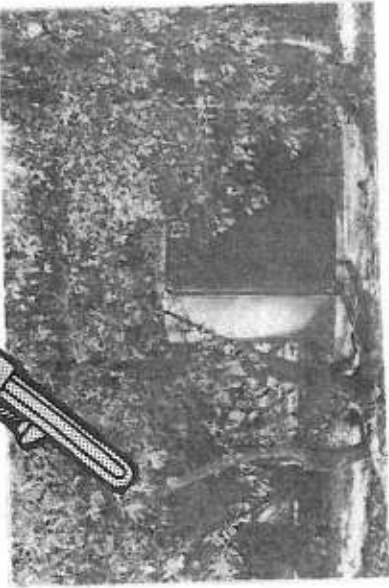
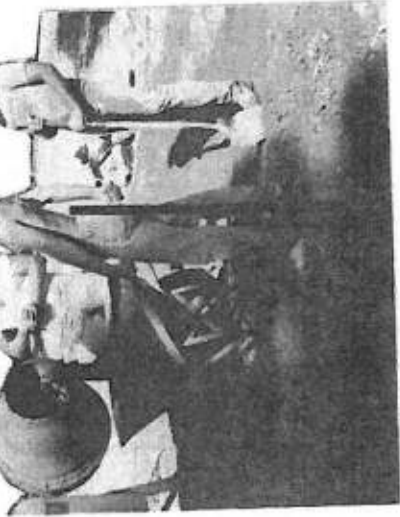
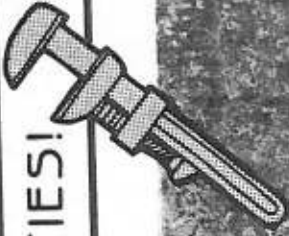

Enjoy the memories this PYLET brings, and be the best you can be.

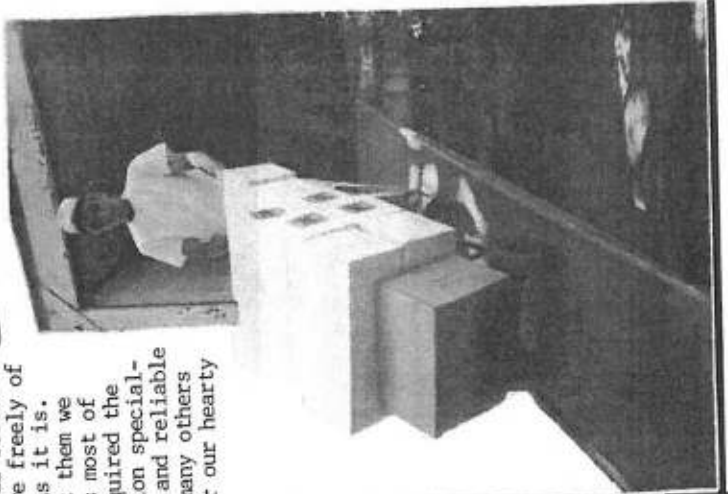

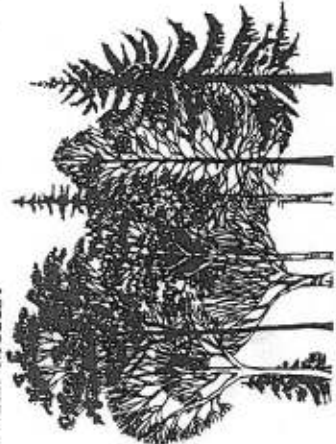
LION MEADOWS

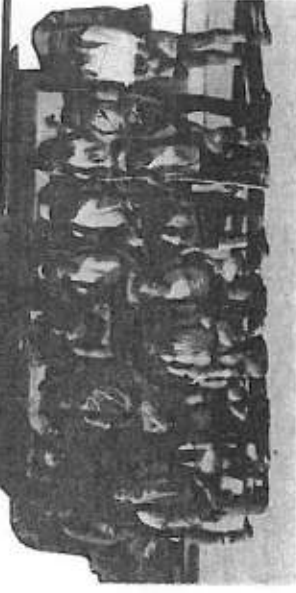

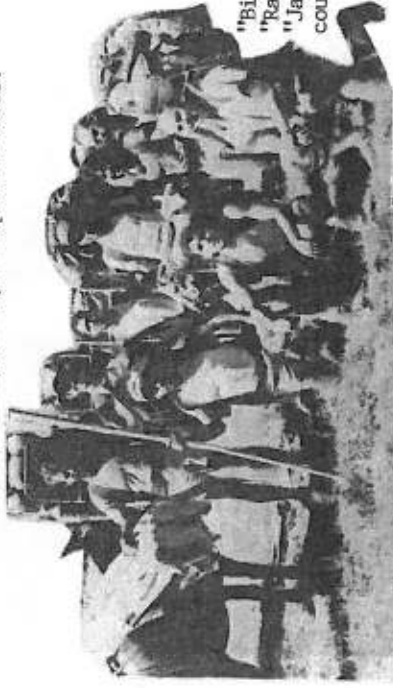

... Pyles Leadership Training (PLT)

Nearly everyone on the Camp staff has "come up through the ranks". In other words, they were once Campers, just like you were this summer. Those who showed promise were invited to go out to Lion Meadows. Some Lionees get recommended for "worker" positions at the Camp (those guys who washed dishes and clothes, helped Nana with the cooking, checked out sports equipment or Outcamp stuff, or worked with the wrangler). Those workers who demonstrate that they have the ability to become counselors are invited back out to Lion Meadows, this time for P.L.T. -- "Pyles Leadership Training". Under the guidance of "senior" counseling staff, these people receive specific training and "hands-on" experience to get them ready for their own groups. With the recommendation of the staff here, these guys join the elite group of Pyles Boys Camp counselors!
