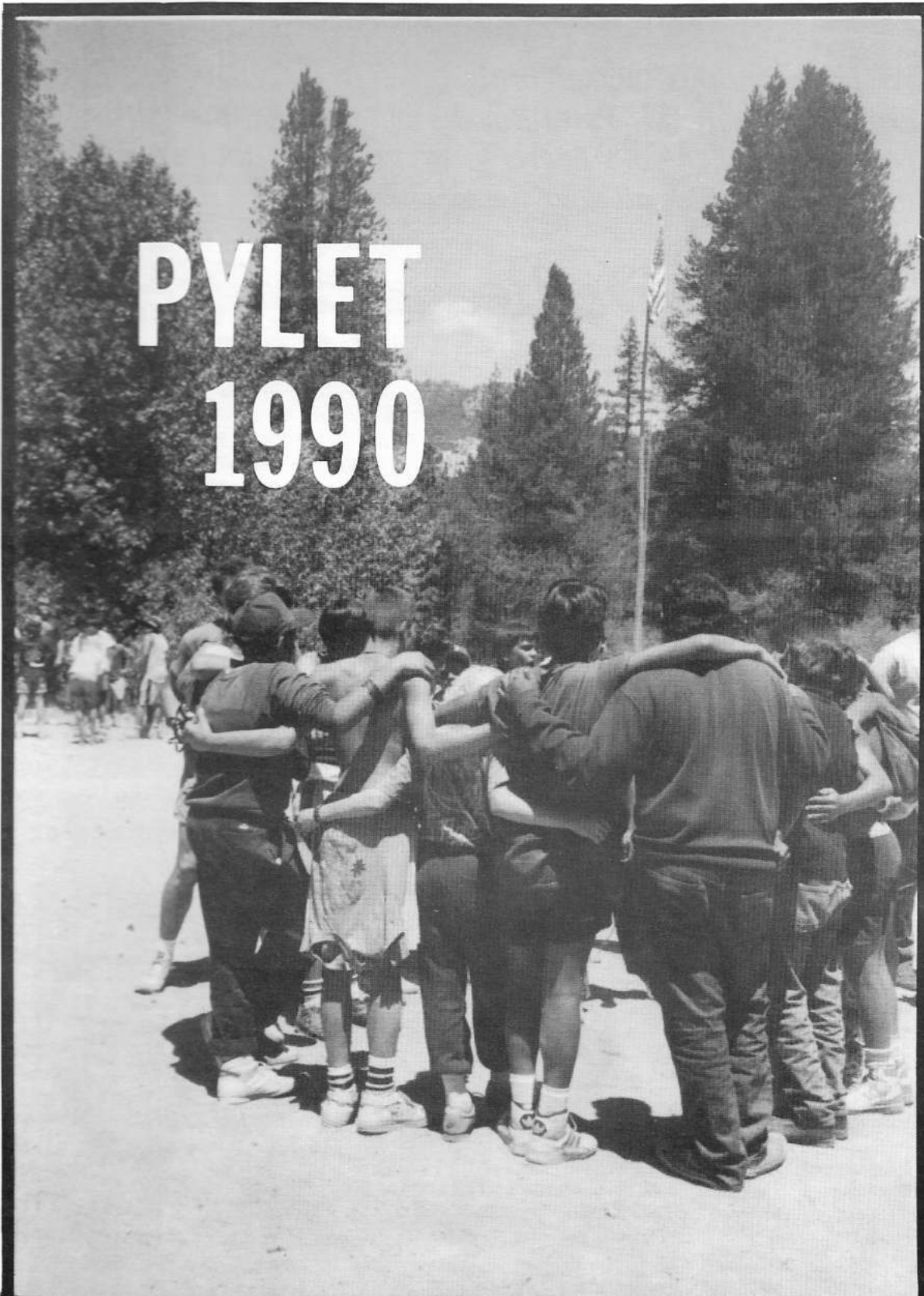

All of you have the potential to succeed, to be the best you there is. How many of you decide to overcome your challenges and achieve that potential is dependent on just one person - YOU!

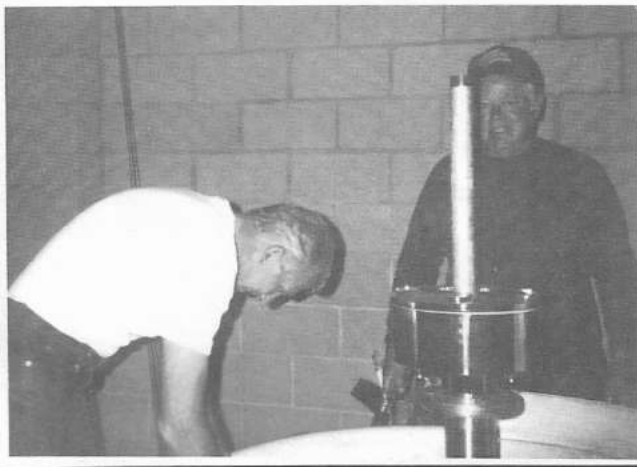
At Pyles we strive to plant a seed. Our home visits, reunions and the Pylet help water that seed, but only you can make it grow.

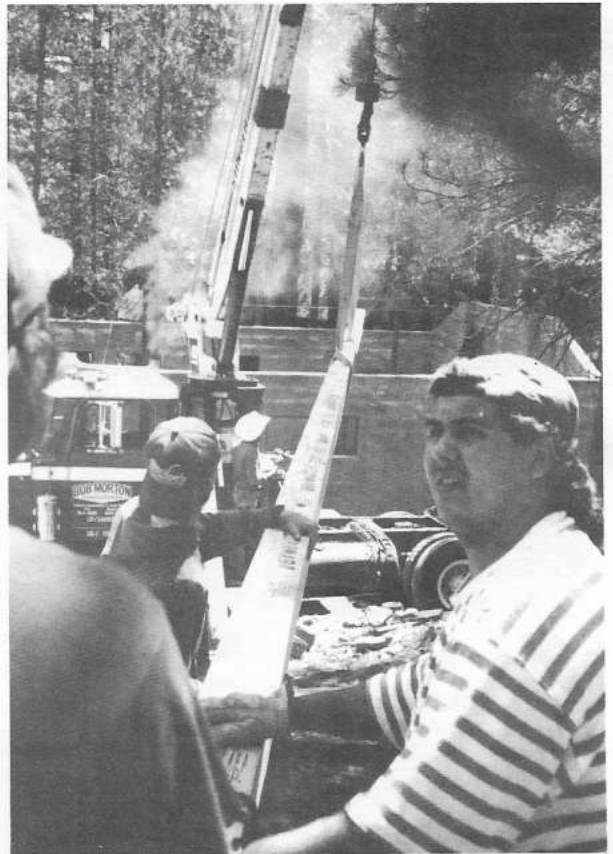

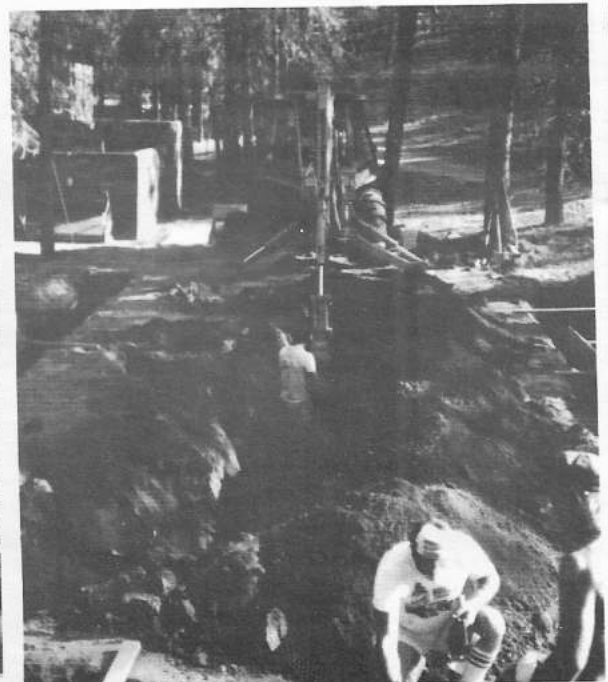

Lion Meadows is a special part of Pyles Boys Camp. Some of you may have gone by Lion on your outcamp.

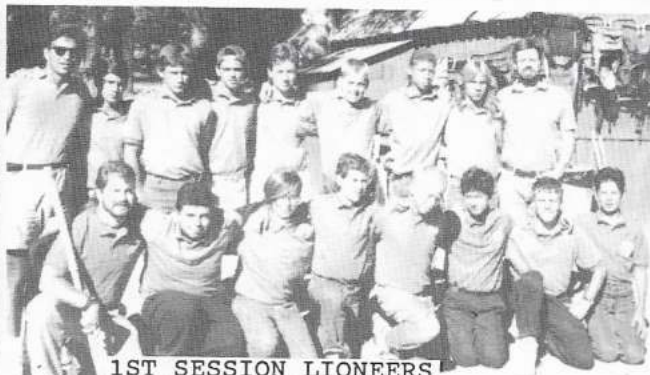

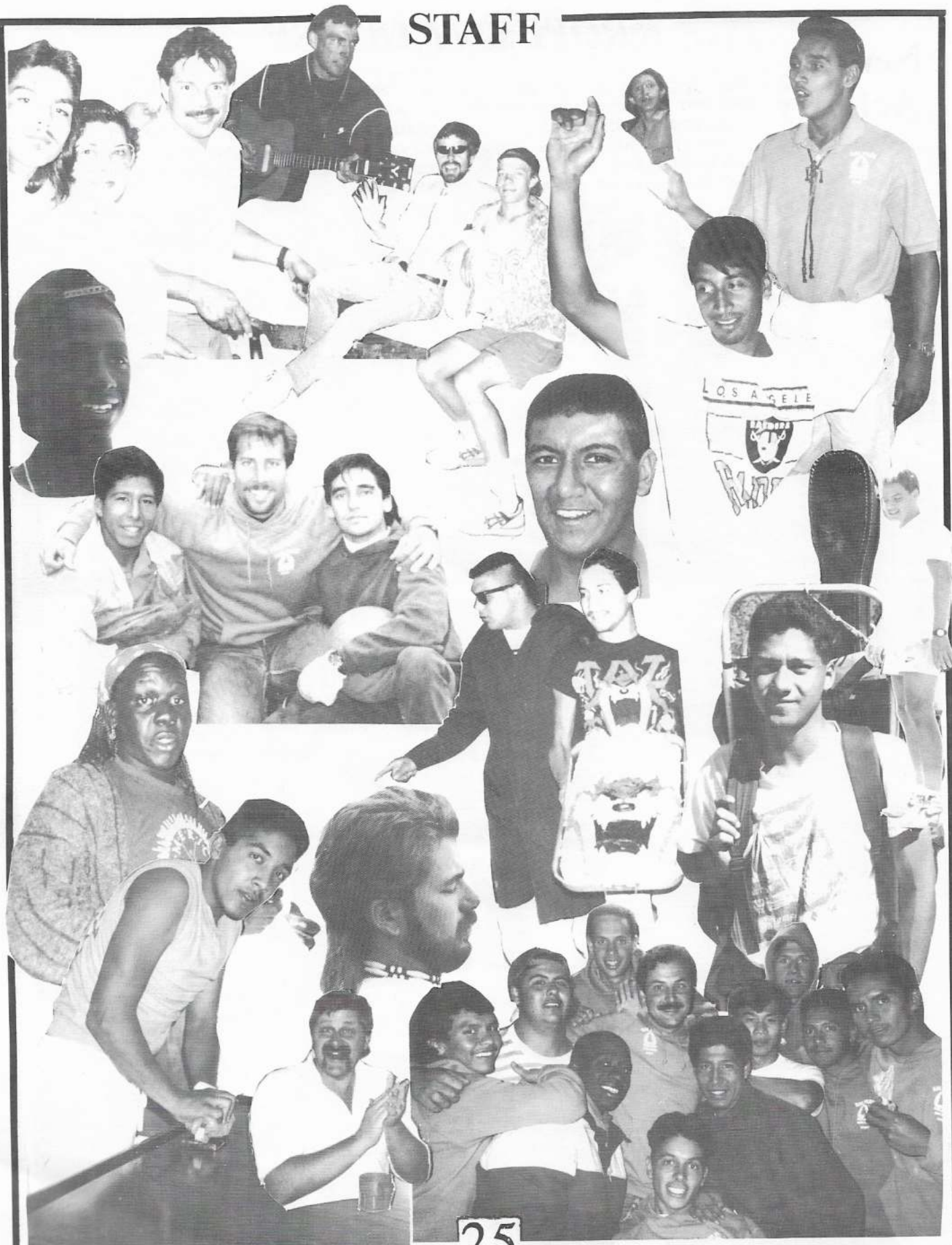
ROPES COURSE
